Pat, a native San Franciscan who grew up in the Sunset District, received her degree in Sociology from the University of San Francisco. Pat is an active member of the [Professional Grief Caregivers' Network](#) in San Francisco and has facilitated grief support groups for children and adults in the Bay Area for over 11 years. She received training at the [Dougy Center](#) in Portland, Oregon, the internationally recognized program that pioneered the model of grief support that Josie's Place employs. In addition to her work with Josie's Place, Pat is a Certified Professional Personal Coach, and works part-time for two non-profit programs housed at San Francisco State University.
